APPLICANTS WANTED FOR LIBRARY BOARD POSITION

[Buena Park] The Buena Park Library District is seeking a letter of interest and resume from individuals wanting to serve on the Library Board of Trustees.

The Buena Park Library District was organized in 1919 under the Education Code of California, Sections 19600-19734. This free public library, governed by an elected, independent library board, provides equal access to library services for all community residents. Trustees serve without pay for a four-year staggered term and may be re-elected.

To qualify, the individual applicant must be 18 years of age and live within the City of Buena Park or within the Library District boundaries. The deadline to apply is July 24, 2017.

The Library Board of Trustees represents the people of Buena Park and provides vital, formal, citizen user guidance to the Library staff in planning, management and evaluation functions. Library Board members are public officials with authority to determine personnel, fiscal and administrative policies as prescribed by Education Code sections 19640 – 19664.

Serving on a Library Board of Trustees constitutes a public trust. It carries with it the responsibility of rendering faithful service and providing enlightened leadership to promote the best possible public service consistent with available funding.

A person assuming a position on the Library Board will be required to file with the County Clerk a Statement of Economic Interests (California Fair Political Practices Commission Form 700) in compliance with the Political Reform Act.

This mid-term vacancy is due to the resignation of long-time trustee, Mary Fuhrman. The term for this seat ends in December 2018.
